Also, please consider the team dynamic as there will be a number of events that are geared toward both the physical and intellectual side of a Scout. Given the diversity of activities, it would be beneficial for a team to reflect that same diversity in both skill and experience.)

COST: \$7 per person if registered by April 11th, 2014
\$10 per person after April 18th, 2014

WHATS INCLUDED: Kickoff Cracker Barrel, Race day snacks, Camporee Patch, Adventure Race Passport, Great prizes for top placing teams

MEALS: Meals will not be provided, and to be cooked by troops patrol method style. Saturday dinner is a pot luck!! Cook enough for your unit plus 4 guest. Please provide a main, side, and dessert.

A Camp-O-Ree like no other you have ever experienced! This special weekend will be the ultimate test in High Adventure, Scouting Skills, and Team Cooperation. Using a map, teams are responsible for traveling together through a series of check points via different disciplines including: trekking, mountain and road biking, paddling (canoes (water level of lake permitting), orienteering, and completing challenge courses thru out the day.

Both mind and body will be put to the test, as this race will last all day, with mandatory breaks throughout. This will be a great activity that will be fun for each scout as they get to work together to overcome some very cool challenges.
